Eviction Moratorium Ends July 31st

The Center for Disease Control's eviction moratorium has been extended. The moratorium will now expire on July 31st. The CDC reports that this is the final extension and the program will end on July 31st.

Individuals with questions about how to file the paper work for the moratorium should call Cleveland Legal Aid at 888-817-3777. Individuals looking for rental assistance can call 2-1-1 or text 898211 for information about local rental assistance or homelessness assistance programs.

FEMA Changes Funeral Assistance Rules

FEMA has changed their pandemic funeral assistance policy to include the families of individuals who died from Covid-19, even if the death certificate doesn't identify Covid-19 as the cause of death.

This new rule applies if the individual died between January 20th, 2020 and May 16th, 2020. The family will need to include a letter from a coroner, medical examiner, or other official that certified the individual's death certificate. The letter must link the death to Covid-19. This change may allow many who applied for the program in the past and were rejected to be able to apply now with the new information.

Income eligible households may qualify if they also meet one or more of the following...

- Individuals age 60 or older.
- Documented medical condition verified by a licensed medical professional.
- COMD-19 diagnosis last 12 months.
- First Percentage of Income Payment Plan Plus (PIPP) or PIPP default.
- Electric bill disconnect notice, has been shut off, or new electric service is being established.

Items you need to provide for your appointment...

- Income documentation for all household members for the past 30 days
- Social Security Card/Birth Certificate/Passport
- Photo I.D./Proof of Citizenship
- Proof/Verification of Medical Condition
- COMD-19 diagnosis
- Most recent electric and gas bills

COVID-19 Vaccine Information

The vaccine is available to anyone 12 or older. 12-17-year-olds can only get the Pfizer vaccine, and must have permission from a parent or guardian.

If you are having trouble signing up for the Covid-19 vaccine, call 2-1-1 for local vaccine information.

There is now a state website where you can find your local vaccine providers and even register with some of them, http://gettheshot.coronavirus.ohio.gov/.
